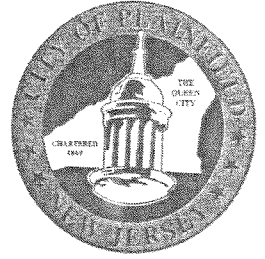

§17:4-2 of the Plainfield Land Use Ordinance states: "Of the 9 regular members, at least 4 members shall be of Classes A and B. All members shall reside in the City. No more than 4 members may reside outside of Historic Districts.

- **Class A:** A person who is knowledgeable in building design and construction or architectural history.
- **Class B:** A person who is knowledgeable, or with a demonstrated interest in, local history.
- **Class C:** Citizen of the municipality who shall hold no other municipal office, position or employment except for membership on the Planning Board or Board of Adjustment.
